## St. Patrick's Day ATA Trap Shoot 3/17

Our first Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA) trap shoot for the 2024 calendar year is set for **Sunday, March 17**. Due to the date, this year it's the "**St. Patrick's Day**" ATA Shoot. We will have the standard three events, 100 singles, 100 handicaps, and 100 doubles targets. There will be trophies for the winners in place and categories for all 3 events, including youth and women! This year's shoots start time is again 10:00 am with registration and practice opening at 8:30am.

Breakfast food and lunch will be available for donations. All donations above reimbursement of costs benefit our youth club trap team, the "**Straight Shooters**". We plan to have some festive food, as well as, trophies fitting to the theme of the shoot!

Youth are very welcome to come and shoot in these events as well as club members and the general public, but all must be ATA members. But, if you are currently not an ATA member (or need to renew) you can join/renew ATA at any ATA shoot, including our shoots. Alternatively, you may join/renew online at the ATA's website <a href="www.shootata.com">www.shootata.com</a> on their membership page. Annual ATA memberships cost only \$20 for adults and \$12 youth 17 and under.

This year our club is holding a total of four registered trap shoots. The three other ATA shoots open to the public are April 21 our "April Open Shoot", August 25 our "Last Chance 500-Doubles and 100-Singles" event, and October 13, the "National Trapshooting Day" Shamrock Leather trophy shoot.

As a reminder, Skeet and 5-Stand will be closed on these ATA dates.

In other shotgun news, the 5-Stand guys are planning on holding some fun monthly **Sporting Clay Shoots** utilizing the 5-Stand equipment, some trap houses, and even the skeet houses could be in the mix. Watch the newsletter and calendar for details and event scheduling.

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## Safety Spot 0

#### READ THESE SAFETY RULES:

- NEVER handle your firearm when ANYONE is downrange on our rifle and pistol ranges!
   We have seen this type of safety infraction on the ranges this year!
- ALWAYS keep the gun pointed in a safe direction! This is a vital and primary gun safety rule.
- ALWAYS keep your finger off
   the trigger until ready to shoot.

   When holding a gun, rest your
   finger on the trigger guard or out
   along the side of the gun.
- ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded and action open until ready to actually use. ...and
- 5. ALWAYS know your target and what's beyond. You must always verify the shot is safe to take and that <u>no one is downrange</u> before pulling that trigger.

Remember, You can't take that shot back! Safety Always Comes First!
