

August 24 ATA Trap Shoot

Sunday, **August 24** will be our next ATA trap shoot and last one for the 2025 ATA target year. It's the "**Last Chance 500-Doubles and 100-Singles" ATA Trap Shoot.** This shoot is essentially a Doubles marathon having up to 5 events each with 100-Doubles targets, and a Singles (16 yard) trap event of 100 targets running concurrently. Remember, you get to shoot whichever events you want to - you do not need to shoot all 500 doubles!

There is no scheduled Handicap event planned, <u>but</u> we can add one if at least 3 people want to shoot it (*please note: there will be no trophies for this event*). Let shoot management know if you would like to shoot a handicap.

Shoot starts at 10 am with registration opening at 8:30am. You can presquad for free by calling 269-483-6803. Pre-squadding helps with planning the event, especially for food!

There will be trophies for all pre-scheduled events, plus there will be food available for donations. Just a reminder, youth shooters are always welcome. It's a great way to get in your last targets for the 2025 ATA shooting year! Sept 1 starts the new ATA year (2026).


